

106 Basics Course: November 14, 2018

“The Section 106 Basics” course will be held on Wednesday, November 14, 2018

Course Location and Accommodations: The course will be held at the Serrano Hotel, 405 Taylor Street, San Francisco, CA 94102. (<https://serranohotel.com/>). A block of rooms has been secured for attendees for Tuesday and Wednesday, November 13-14, at the prevailing government per diem rate. It is recommended that you make your reservations early, as the rooms are likely to sell out. **Reservations must be made by October 13.** Guests will make room reservations directly to the Hotel's Reservations Department at 1-866-575-9941. To insure receiving the special group rate, the guests must identify the group name ACHP-Basics Course Room Block.

Hotel Information: An Art Deco landmark on the National Register of Historic Places, Serrano Hotel blends old-world charm with contemporary services and amenities.

Registration: Registration will be located outside the conference room Wednesday at 8:00 a.m. Plan to stop by the registration desk to check in and to pick up your course notebook and other course materials.
